RODUCTION-BASED, DIRT track racing has been the lifeblood of American motorcycle racing for years but it's only become a part of British motorcycle sport in recent years.

Although there are really top class competitors, like former speedway star and three-time British Dirt Track champion Aiden Collins (a Honda UK-backed rider), Suzuki-backed Peter Boast and official Team Kawasaki rider 15-year-old Oliver Brindley who has raced and beat the best kids in the States (he's the son of former World Sidecar racer Derek who is also a top dirt tracker these days!), the racing itself is incredible fiercely fought, yet the sport is still at grass (dirt?) roots level.

That means it's free to get in, the paddock is a wonderful, easy-going place to wander round to check out the bikes and what's more, there's a new classic class this year, which is attracting a whole new bunch of really interesting bikes. www.dirttrackriders.co.uk
